

## Overview

The principal role of the Community Center Task Force is to present research findings and make recommendations to the City Council for further study or action. No final decision-making authority rests with the committee.

The objectives of this committee include:

1. Research and summarize for City Council an assessment of the indoor recreation and community space needs in Chelsea. Provide facility recommendations.
2. Research, review, and summarize the costs of construction, maintenance and operation of a City of Chelsea owned/operated Community Center.
3. Research and identify methods for funding the construction, maintenance, and operation of a community center.
4. Review and recommend opportunities for cooperation with community partners such as Chelsea Community Schools, Chelsea Hospital, Chelsea Aquatic Club, and other Health and Wellness Facilities etc.
5. Other items as requested by City Council.
